Two of these will appear as Photograph of the Month.

Through the internet I have been able to find copies of the Grayshott entries in Kelly's and Whites directories for 1878, 1885, 1889, 1895, 1911 and 1920. This has provided much valuable information to the early formation of the village.

It is hoped that the Archive will be able over the Christmas period this year have a 'Know your history of Grayshott' display at Keats, estate agents in the Square.
